Les Berges du Rhône









Webster University Geneva offers full-time students housing within 10 kilometres of campus. Residence "Les Berges du Rhône" is centrally located on the banks of the river Rhone, and is well serviced by public transportation, both train and bus. All types of units are fully furnished. We offer shared facilities in suites or private studio apartments, subject to availability. We are unable to accommodate families.

All University and Residential Policies apply there. Contracts are subject to review every semester. Webster reserves the right to terminate a contract if the student violates policy. Please refer to our Housing Policy Booklet. Every student upon arrival will sign a contract that binds him/her to all rules or regulations stipulated in our Student Handbook and the Housing Policy Booklet.

Webster Geneva aims to provide clean, secure and pleasant student accommodation which all students can enjoy.

RESIDENCE LES BERGES DU RHONE







The residence "Les Berges du Rhône" is a "V" shaped edifice, located on the banks of the river Rhone and facing the 'Pont de Sous-Terre'. The bridge connects the communes of 'Junction' and 'St. Jean' in the centre of Geneva. Its large picture windows afford lots of light. Les Berges accommodates 72 students.









The building Amenities at 'Les Berges du Rhône'

- Wireless Internet access
- Well serviced by public transportation one minute walk to the bus stop!
- Public parking 5 minutes' walk at Seujet, Finances and David Dufour
- Security cameras and Security night guard
- Nearby jogging along a nature path
- 3 Assistant Resident Coordinators (ARCs)

Overview - type of units

- Double shared studio: two beds, kitchenette, and ensuite bathroom.
- Suites: single and shared bedrooms, 2 shared ensuite bathrooms, and a kitchen.
- Single studios: kitchenette, ensuite bathroom.

Additional Information:

- Rent includes: internet connection, electricity, heating and hot water.
- Some terms we may have more students seeking accommodation than available rooms.
 There may be times when shared rooms become a necessity for a period of time when demand is greater than available rooms.
- Rooms at 'Les Berges du Rhône' may not be available before or after the designated arrival or departure dates, so please make alternative housing arrangements if you plan to come early or stay longer.
- Note: Webster reserves the right to make room changes and consolidate roommates temporarily: if a resident vacates a room, the remaining student must be willing to accept another roommate or move to another space when requested by the university to do so.
- "Les Berges du Rhône" cannot accommodate family members.
- Residents are required to sign a housing contract prior to move-in.
- All Webster Geneva residents are required to subscribe to Personal Liability Insurance at a cost of approximately CHF100 per year.



Housing applications are not placed upon the housing priority list until the student is accepted to Webster University. Further, a room is not assigned until the Geneva Business office has received the CHF 1,000.- housing deposit.

Housing deposits for new students are refundable until the following dates:

- o 30 June for students whose entry term is the Fall semester
- o 1 October for students whose entry term is the Spring semester
- o 1 February for students whose entry term is the Summer term

I understand that Webster University will treat my housing deposit as a security deposit. Therefore deposits are not refundable until after the student has vacated university housing and all housing related charges have been paid.

After you sign and submit this form, if you no longer require student housing for any reason, you must notify the Residential Life Office at least six weeks prior to the start of the term or you will be held liable for all outstanding rent for the term.
