IMPORTANT:

Payments for all balances (including outstanding housing and other charges) for **the Summer 2023 term** are due by: **Friday 26 May 2023**

Payments for all balances (including outstanding housing and other charges) for **the Fall 2023 semester** are due by: <u>Friday 25 August 2023</u>. Full-time undergraduate students in good financial standing have the option to pay the first 50% of the tuition by <u>Friday 25 August 2023</u> and the second 50% prior to the beginning of the second part of the semester: <u>Friday 27 October 2023</u>.

Payments for all balances (including outstanding housing and other charges) for the Spring 2024 semester are due by: <u>Friday 19 January 2024</u>. Full-time undergraduate students in good financial standing have the option to pay the first 50% of the tuition by <u>Friday 19 January 2024</u>, and the second 50% by <u>Friday 22 March 2024</u>.

Students who do not pay within the deadline will incur a late fee of $\underline{\text{CHF 200}}$, and all course registration activity may be suspended pending payment in full (including the late fee).

Continuing degree-seeking students (both UG and GR) are required to enroll for the next semester before the end of the current semester. Failure to do so will result in a late registration fee of <u>CHF 175</u>.

¹ An undergraduate (UG) student is defined as Full-time if registered for 12-18 credit hours at any time for a semester. <u>All</u> full-time UG students are subject to the flat fee, even if they withdraw to fewer than 12 credit hours. At the discretion of the Academic Director and in order to maintain full-time status, UG students who do not satisfactorily complete 30 credit hours during the academic year will be required to attend Summer courses.

² Webster Geneva has two 16-week semesters per year: FALL (includes the 8-week Fall1 term and the 8-week Fall2 term) and SPRING (includes the 8-week Spring1 term and the 8-week Spring 2 term). Webster Geneva also offers one 8-week Summer term.

³ Textbooks (and/or e-books) for both undergraduate and graduate courses are included with the tuition price. <u>This policy does not cover the following</u>: textbooks/e-books for Online courses, exceptional costs such as lab fees or field trip expenses, and accessories such as notebooks, pencils, etc. Please note that <u>availability of textbooks and/or e-books at the beginning of the term depends on advance registration</u>. Also please note that a one-time Graduation Petition Fee (CHF 50.00) is charged separately to graduating students.

⁴ Textbooks (and/or e-books) are <u>not</u> included in the tuition for Online courses, and must be purchased separately by the student.
